

Call for papers to 2025, Vol 8, Issue 2 of kritisk etnografi: Swedish Journal of Anthropology

Launched in 2018, the journal has so far published seven volumes with two issues per year. In 2025, we plan to publish two *Varia* issues, that is, non-thematic issues bringing together diverse papers when it comes to thematic and/or geographical orientation. To do this, we need contributions from our readers, and colleagues. We look for papers that use ethnography critically to discuss topics that have a potential to bring broad audiences into engagement with anthropological perspectives. This is also a great opportunity to make your research known in Swedish as well as international contexts.

kritisk etnografi – Swedish Journal of Anthropology is an independent journal run by researchers, and as such, it presents a tangible alternative to the business model of commercial publishers. The journal is peer-reviewed, online, open access without any costs for authors or readers, and publishes original research articles, as well as reports from Swedish anthropological community. It is owned and published by the Swedish Society for Anthropology and Geography (*Svenska Sällskapet för Antropologi och Geografi*).
